A Well Stocked Sewing Kit

Every needleworker should have stitchery equipment assembled in one place and ready for use whenever they work on a project. A basic sewing kit should include all the tools and items which you use regularly, along with a few which will be used occasionally.

Your basic sewing kit should include:

Nametag

Needles: Embroidery, Chenille, Milliners – for surface work

Tapestry - for counted work

Beading – for beading

Scissors (2 pairs: 1 just for threads & 1 for everything else)

Washable marking pen or HB pencil (and sharpener)

Stitch Book (i.e. 100 Embroidery Stitches)

Hoops (a 10 cm. [4"] and a 15 cm [6"])
